**Prof Isak Fruomin** is a Head of the Institute of Education at National Research University “Higher School of Economics” in Moscow (Russia) - first graduate school of education in Russia. Fruomin was leading the World Bank education program in Russia from 1999 to 2011. His World Bank experience also extends to the projects in Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Afghanistan, Nepal, Turkmenistan and India. Prof Fruomin is an Honored Teacher of Russia. In 2012 – 2016 he was an advisor to the Minister of Education and Science of Russia Federation. In 2016-2018 he was a member of the team that created a strategy of socio-economic development of the Russian Federation (Education part). Prof Fruomin is an editor and author of more than 250 publications including articles and books on educational reform and theory of education in Russian and English.
