Professor Eryaman serves as the president of World Education Research Association. He has served as the president of International Association of Educators (INASED) and as a Research Expert at the European Commission. He has worked as a DAAD-TUBITAK professor at the Institute for International Comparative and Intercultural Education in the University of Hamburg, Germany for two years. He was a visiting Professor and Honorary Research Fellow at the Institute for Policy Studies in Education at London Metropolitan University, UK in 2011. He received his MEd from the University of Missouri-Columbia and his PhD from the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign, USA. Professor Eryaman has served as a council member at the European Educational Research Association from 2009 to 2018. He currently serves as the series editor of a Springer Book series entitled "Education Science, Evidence and the Public Good" and as the regional editor of the "Bloomsbury Education and Childhood Studies" series of Bloomsbury Publishing.

He is the managing editor of International Journal of Progressive Education; the author of Teaching as Practical Philosophy (2008) and Using Big Data in Evidence Informed School Evaluation (2021), and the book editor of Evidence and Public Good in Educational Policy, Research and Practice (2017), International Handbook of Progressive Education (2015); Accountability and Transparency in Education: Global Challenges and Local Realities (2014) and Peter McLaren, Education, and the Struggle for Liberation (2009).
